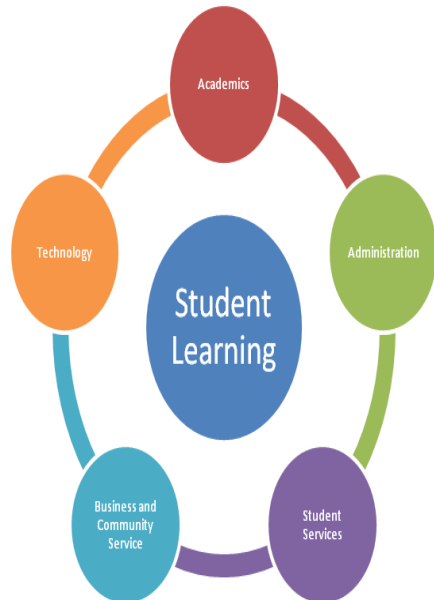

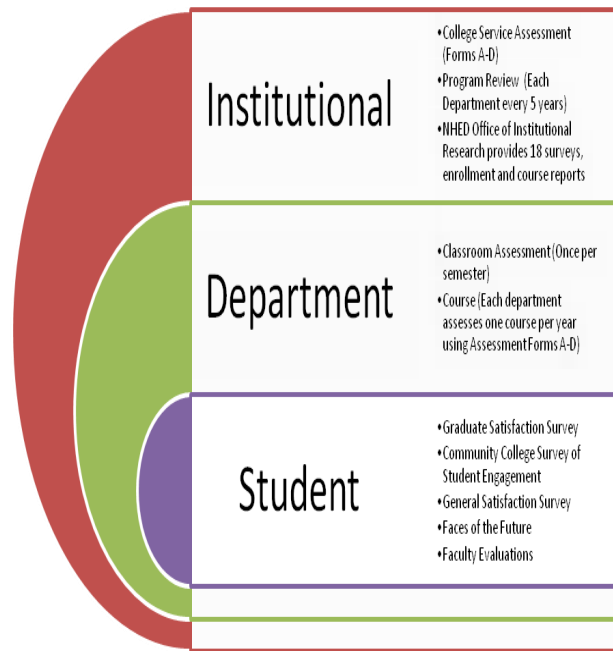
Moving in New Directions

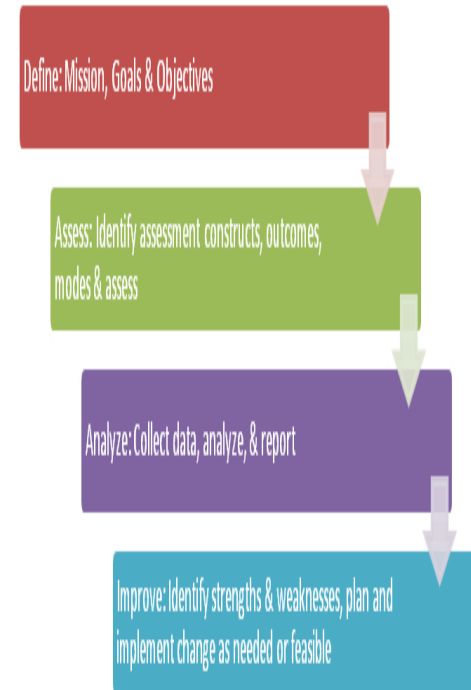
