ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS

THE ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRE A SEPARATE APPLICATION FOUND ON THE LAST PAGE OF OUR GENERAL APPLICATION

\$500 Non-Traditional Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$500 (\$250 each semester) to a non-traditional student who enrolls as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College after being out of high school at least two years prior to attending college. This scholarship will be awarded to two students. These awards will be based on scholastic ability and financial need and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0

\$800 Returning Sophomore Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$800 (\$400 each semester) to a freshman who enrolls for the sophomore year as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. This scholarship targets the student who has demonstrated significant Community involvement through private and public organizations as well as individual voluntary efforts. This award will be based on community involvement and financial need and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0

\$600 Entering Freshman Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$600 (\$300 each semester) to a high school senior who enrolls as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. This scholarship will be awarded to two students. These awards will be based on scholastic ability and financial needs and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE SPECIALIST

\$500 Andrew A. Lang Memorial Scholarship - Four \$500

One \$500 scholarship will be given to a student who is enrolled in the accounting and/or economics, business field of study. The recipient must maintain a 3.0 GPA, be an Iron Range resident and a full-time student at MRCTC.

\$300 Miners National Bank Scholarship – One \$300

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$500 Trenti Law Firm Scholarship – One \$500

Student enrolled in the Administrative Office Specialist Program, returning for their 2nd year. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$400 Fabiola Club Scholarship – One \$400

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipients must be a resident of Eveleth or Virginia.

\$500 The Lassila Family Memorial Scholarship - One \$500

One \$500 scholarship given in memory of Arne and Margaret Lassila is awarded to a student majoring in business. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. The donors will be actively involved in the selection process.

\$150 The Ed Grierson Memorial Scholarship -One \$150

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Preference will be given to a student who has completed the first semester of the Auto program.

\$250 Jeremy Jindra Memorial Scholarship -One \$250

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement, demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient will be selected by the family.

GRAPHICS SCHOLARSHIPS

\$2300 Japs-Olson Scholarship – One or Two \$2300 each

Recipient will be a full time student enrolled in the Graphic Design & Print Communications Program. The student will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement, demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Selection will be made by the programs instructors.

\$100 Pro-Print Scholarship – One \$100

Recipient will be a full time student chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement, demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$200 Service Printers Scholarship – One \$200

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 2.5), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$400 Eveleth Lions Scholarship – One \$400

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 2.5), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient must be a graduate of Eveleth/Gilbert High School.

\$250 Bob Lent Scholarship – One \$250

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 2.5), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Student must be an entering freshman and a graduate of a Duluth High School.

\$500 Tom Griffin Memorial - N.C.S. Scholarship – Two \$500 or One \$1000

A student returning for their second year in the Graphic Design & Print Communications program will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 2.5), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Priority will be given to a student who intends to make the Iron Range a place of employment. Selection will be made by the programs instructors.

\$400 Eveleth Lions Scholarship – One \$400

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient must be a graduate of Eveleth/Gilbert High School.

NURSING SCHOLARSHIPS

\$500 Voiture 40 & 8 Scholarship – One \$500

Student enrolled in the Nursing Program, returning for their 3rd semester. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 2.5), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Preference will be given to a family member or relative of a member of the Voiture 40 & 8 Club. The program director of the nursing program will be involved in the selection process.

\$500 Soroptimists Club Scholarship – One \$500

One non-traditional female recipient shall be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

A tuition grant awarded to two deserving high school graduates of the Iron Range area, based on need and promise with minimum GPA of 2.5 and enrolled at MRCTC as a full time student, pursuing the field of their choice. Payment of this scholarship will be \$750 for the for the fall semester and \$750 for the spring semester.

\$500 The Dave Stillman Memorial Scholarship – One \$500-Dual Campus*

One scholarship is awarded each year in memory of Dave Stillman, whose motto was "Livin the Dream".

This award is directed to a deserving high school graduate of the Arrowhead Region of Northeastern Minnesota.
