ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS

THE ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRE A SEPARATE APPLICATION FOUND ON THE LAST PAGE OF OUR GENERAL APPLICATION

\$1000 F. B. Moe Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$1000 (\$500 each semester) to an outstanding freshman who enrolls for the sophomore year at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. It is provided in memory of Floyd B. Moe who was a long time educator and administrator in the Virginia college system. This award will be based on scholastic ability and requires a minimum GPA of 3.5

\$800 William Monat Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$800 (\$400 each semester) to a freshman who enrolls in an education (teaching) major for the sophomore year at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. It is provided in memory of William Monat who was a long time educator, coach, and administrator in the Virginia college system. This award will be based on scholastic ability and financial need and requires a minimum GPA of 3.2

\$500 Non-Traditional Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$500 (\$250 each semester) to a non-traditional student who enrolls as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College after being out of high school at least two years prior to attending college. This scholarship will be awarded to two students. These awards will be based on scholastic ability and financial need and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0

\$800 Returning Sophomore Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$800 (\$400 each semester) to a freshman who enrolls for the sophomore year as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. This scholarship targets the student who has demonstrated significant Community involvement through private and public organizations as well as individual voluntary efforts. This award will be based on community involvement and financial need and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0

\$1200 Margaret Wallin Marvin Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$1200 (\$600 each semester) to a freshman who enrolls for the sophomore year as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. It is provided in memorial to Margaret Wallin Marvin who, for more than 30 years, has been a member and supporter of the Alumni Association. Two scholarships will be awarded to students expressing an interest in teaching and who demonstrate good character and show leadership skills. A minimum GPA of 2.8 is required.

\$600 Entering Freshman Scholarship

This scholarship is a tuition grant of \$600 (\$300 each semester) to a high school senior who enrolls as a full-time student at Mesabi Range Community and Technical College. This scholarship will be awarded to two students. These awards will be based on scholastic ability and financial needs and requires a minimum GPA of 3.0

BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIPS

\$500 Wells Fargo Bank Business Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student whose cost of tuition, books, and fees exceed the amount of grant aid and scholarships for which he/she is eligible. The student must be a resident of the Wells Fargo Marketing Area – Angora, Aurora, Bear River, Biwabik, Britt, Buhl, Buyck, Cook, Cotton, Crane Lake, Ely, Eveleth, Forbes, Gheen, Gilbert, Greaney, Hoyt Lakes, Iron, Makinen, McKinley, Mountain Iron, Nett Lake, Orr, Pike Sandy, Virginia, Winton, or Zim. The recipient must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and must be returning to MRCTC – Virginia Campus for his/her sophomore year and majoring in business.

\$200 Clint Coombe Business Scholarship – One \$200

One \$200 scholarship is given to a returning student majoring in Business. This scholarship is given in memory of Clint Coombe who began as a college registrar at Mesabi Community College in November 1968. In July 1982, he became the Director of College Services. He retired on January 28, 1994 and died in 1996.

\$800 Walker, Giroux, and Hahne, LTD Accounting Scholarship – One \$800

One \$800 annual scholarship is given to an outstanding accounting major returning to MRCTC. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$500 Norri Distributing Company Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in business. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$200 David and Frances Milavetz Memorial Award – One \$200

One \$200 monetary award is given to a student in the Business Administration field.

\$500 Andrew A. Lang Memorial Scholarship - Four \$500

Four \$500 scholarships will be given to a student who is enrolled in the accounting and/or economics field of study. The recipient must maintain a 3.0 GPA, be an Iron Range resident and a full-time student at MRCTC

\$500 The Lassila Family Memorial Scholarship - \$ One \$500 – Dual Campus

One \$500 scholarship given in memory of Arne and Margaret Lassila is awarded to a student majoring in business. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. The donors will be actively involved in the selection process.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE SPECIALIST

\$300 Miners National Bank Scholarship – One \$300

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$500 Trenti Law Firm Scholarship – One \$500

Student enrolled in the Administrative Office Specialist Program, returning for their 2nd year. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$400 Fabiola Club Scholarship – One \$400

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipients must be a resident of Eveleth or Virginia.

JOURNALISM SCHOLARSHIPS

\$250 Mesabi Daily News Scholarship – Two \$250

Two \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a student studying journalism or computer science. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$800 Ruth Kanianen and Bob Clark Education Scholarship and Journalism Scholarship –Two \$800

Two cash awards of \$800 each are given to students majoring in journalism/education. Recipients will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

ENGINEERING/SCIENCE/MATH SCHOLARSHIPS

\$5000 The Johnson Family Scholarship– One \$5000, \$2500 annually

REQUIRES RECOMMENDATION FROM MATH OR SCIENCE INSTRUCTOR

One \$2500 annual scholarship awarded to an Entering Freshman at MRCTC that is strongly dedicated to his or her field of Engineering, Math or the Sciences. The donors will be actively involved in the selection of the recipient and do not put emphasis on a minimum G.P.A. but rather a student who is focused, hard working and determined to succeed in the above field. Scholarship is renewable for the Sophomore year if qualifications are met. Payment will be dispensed in the amount of \$1250 per semester.

\$500 NORAMCO Engineering Corporation Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship given to a student attending MRCTC – Virginia Campus and are planning to enter their junior year at a four-year college. Student must be pursuing a degree in an engineering field and must be completing their second year of study at MRCTC – Virginia Campus to be eligible for these awards. Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.70 or better through the first term of their sophomore year. The awards will be provided to graduates of Mesabi Iron Range high schools. NORAMCO employee dependents shall receive preference over all other applicants. Preference for both awards shall be given to students who are not receiving more than \$100 in scholarships from other sources. Scholarship recipients will be sent their \$500 award after they have provided the MRCTC – Virginia Campus Financial Aid Office a photocopy of their paid tuition statement, showing proof of actual enrollment.

\$500 ArcelorMittal Minorca Mine Inc. Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is given to a student majoring in Science, including chemistry, physics, math, or engineering. Student must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average.

\$500 Selmer Hoff Engineering Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is given to a student majoring in Engineering. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement, with no minimum GPA requirement, demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship,

school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Priority will be given to a student not having been selected for another scholarship.

\$500 Marjorie Schmitt Memorial Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in the fields of Science. Preference will be given to a female Native American, African American or non traditional student. Marjorie Bangs Schmitt was an instructor at Mesabi from 1970-1989 teaching Chemistry. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PRE-LAW SCHOLARSHIPS

\$500 The Trenti Law Scholarship – One \$500

One tuition grant of \$500 is awarded to a pre-law student who enrolls for his/her sophomore year at MRCTC, Virginia Campus.

\$250 Jeremy Carpenter Memorial Scholarship – One \$250

One \$250 tuition grant is given to a student majoring in Education, Law Enforcement or related legal field with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0. This award is given through the Norse Club at Mesabi Range College in memory of Jeremy, a past student.

\$500 Eino Kopponen Memorial – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in the legal field, preferably an attorney. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$500 Joseph J. Rebovich Memorial – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in law enforcement. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS

One \$1000 Walfred H. Bodas Education Scholarship – Two \$1000

Two scholarships awarded each year in memory of Walfred H. Bodas. The scholarships will be awarded to returning sophomores enrolling at MRCTC as full-time students. The students must be planning to make teaching his/her career. A minimum GPA of 3.5 during the students' freshman year is required.

MEDICAL AND DENTAL SCHOLARSHIPS

\$3500 The Elmer & Claudine Hane Memorial Scholarship – One \$3500

A tuition grant awarded to a deserving MRCTC Freshman returning for their sophomore year and pursuing the field of Medical Technology. The recipient must be a full time student with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Payment of this scholarship will be \$1500 for the fall semester and \$1500 for the spring semester, with criteria verification.

\$1000 Virginia Regional Medical Center Auxiliary Scholarship – One \$1000 - Dual Campus**

One \$1000 award is given to a graduating sophomore student studying in a health-related field. The recipient must have maintained a 3.0 GPA during their year at MRCTC, possess good character and personality. The Auxiliary Committee will make the selection for this award.

\$500 Sadie W. Holm Memorial Scholarship – One \$500 – Dual Campus**

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student excelling in a nursing or education major. The student must be majoring in education, nursing, or nursing education. The student must have a GPA above 3.5 and must be returning to MRCTC for their sophomore year.

\$1000 Joanne Lindgren Memorial Scholarship – One \$1000 – Dual Campus **

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient will be a student majoring in the field of medicine or pursuing a nursing degree. This scholarship is given in memory of Mrs. Joanne Lindgren who dedicated her life to nursing and helping others.

\$300 Dr. G. H. Rowell Memorial Scholarship – One \$300

One tuition grant of \$300 (\$150 each semester) is awarded annually to an outstanding student in pre-dentistry.

\$500 George V. Kajala Memorial – One \$500

One scholarship of \$500 is given in memory of Dr. George V. Kajala who specialized in Orthodontic Dentistry in Virginia since 1972. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient will be a student majoring in the field of pre-dentistry. Recipient is selected by the family.

\$500 Marian E. Haij Memorial Scholarship – One \$500 – Dual Campus **

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient will be a student majoring in the field of medicine or pursuing a nursing degree. This scholarship is given in memory of Marian Haij an alumni of Mesabi Range College.

HUMAN SERVICES SCHOLARSHIPS

\$200 Jamie Honkola Scholarship – One \$200

One \$200 scholarship is awarded to a returning student who will be focusing their studies on children and has determined Human Relations as their major.

\$200 Lance Nevin Scholarship – One \$200

One \$200 scholarship is awarded to a returning student who will be focusing their studies on the Chemical Dependency field with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

\$200 Elias Clayton, Elmer Jackson and Isaac McGhie Memorial – Two \$200

Two \$200 scholarships are given to students who have taken or are enrolled in Human Relations; who are involved with organizations or activities that benefit Minority groups and are able to document as to why he/she is active and Committed to them. GPA of 2.5 or higher.

\$200 Del Case Memorial – One \$200

One \$200 scholarship is awarded to a student continuing their studies in Chemical Dependency, with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

\$200 Mr. K & Koogrr General– Three \$200

Award given to students continuing in the field of human services. The student must have completed or be currently enrolled in the human services program major maintaining a 3.0 GPA.

\$600.00 Veronick and Standard Scholarship – One \$600

One \$600 scholarship is awarded to a student who will be focusing their studies on the Chemical Dependency field with a minimum GPA of 3.0. The donors will be involved in the selection process.

NATIVE AMERICAN SCHOLARSHIP

\$500 Marjorie Schmitt Memorial Scholarship – One \$500

One \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student majoring in the fields of Science. Preference will be given to a Native American or female student. Marjorie Bangs Schmitt was an instructor at Mesabi from 1970-1989 teaching Chemistry. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

\$4000 C.E. "Bud and Lillian Kishel Memorial – One \$4000 – Dual Campus**

One \$4000 full annual scholarship awarded to a returning Sophomore student at MRCTC that is strongly dedicated to his or her field of study. The donors will be actively be involved in the selection of the recipient and do not put emphasis on a minimum G.P.A. but rather a student who is focused, hard working and determined to succeed in their chosen field. Payment will be \$2000 for fall and \$2000 for spring semesters.

\$3500 Emil A. Erickson Memorial Scholarship – One \$3500

One \$3500 full tuition scholarship will be given in memory of Emil A. Erickson, a long time educator at the Virginia Junior College. A full time student from the eastern iron range area studying history, philosophy, and science related fields such as chemistry and physics will be given preference. The donors will be actively involved in the selection of the recipient, require a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 and may request a personal interview with the 3 finalists. Payment will be \$1750 for fall and \$1750 for spring semester.

\$500 Virginia Elks Club – Two \$500

Two \$500 scholarships awarded to returning sophomores majoring in their field of choice. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Preference will be given to children of Elks Lodge Members. A special selection committee set up by the Elks Club does selection.

\$500 Virginia Lion's Club Scholarship – One \$500

One tuition grant of \$500 awarded to a freshman who enrolls for their sophomore year at MRCTC. Selection is made from among the top-ranking freshmen.

\$500 Soroptimist International of Virginia, Minnesota Memorial Scholarship –

One non-traditional sophomore recipient shall be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community. Involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as result of receiving this scholarship.

\$500 American Association of University Women Scholarship (A.A.U.W.)—One \$500

One \$500 award is given to a non-traditional, female student. The student must be returning to MRCTC and maintain a GPA of 3.3 or above. Selection is made by this organization.

\$500 Virginia Women of Today – One \$500

One \$500 award are given to a non-traditional, female student. The student must be returning to MRCTC as a sophomore and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above. Selection is made by Virginia W.O.T. Scholarship Committee.

\$225 Beta Sigma Phi Scholarship – One \$225 -Dual Campus**

Recipient shall be a non-traditional female chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient will be returning to MRCTC.

\$250 Savolainen Scholarship – One \$250

One tuition grant of \$250 is given to an outstanding freshman upon returning to MRCTC – Virginia Campus. A memorial to Hedwig Savolainen and Peter Savolainen by Mary Savolainen Pickett, this grant is awarded on the basis of leadership qualities, scholarship, and career potential.

\$500 Advancing & Benefiting Women Alliance Scholarship – Two to Three \$500 – Dual Campus**

Recipients shall be a non-traditional female chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Recipient will be returning to MRC&TC and the organization does the selection of the recipient.

\$500 Lake Country Power – One \$500 – Dual Campus**

A n entering or returning student from the Iron Range area serviced by Lake Country Power. Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship.

\$250 Eastern Star: Biwabik Chapter #262 Scholarship – One \$250

Recipients shall be full time students returning to MRCTC and chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship. Selection is made by the club.

\$800 The Twin City Iron Rangers Association Scholarship – One \$800

Scholarship is given based on scholarship and financial need. Recipient must maintain at least a 2.5 (B-) average and be from the Iron Range Area.

A tuition grant awarded to a deserving high school graduate of the East Iron Range area, based on need and promise with minimum GPA of 3.0 and enrolled at MRCTC as a full time student. This scholarship is renewable for the students' Sophomore year if criteria is continued to be met. Payment of this scholarship will be \$2000 in the fall semester and \$2000 in the spring semester, with criteria verification.

\$5000 The Johnson Family Scholarship– One \$5000, \$2500 annually REQUIRES RECOMMENDATION FROM MATH OR SCIENCE INSTRUCTOR

One \$2500 annual scholarship awarded to an Entering Freshman at MRCTC that is strongly dedicated to his or her field of Engineering, Math or the Sciences. The donors will be actively involved in the selection of the recipient and do not put emphasis on a minimum G.P.A. but rather a student who is focused, hard working and determined to succeed in the above field. Scholarship is renewable for the Sophomore year if qualifications are met. Payment will be dispensed in the amount of \$1250 per semester.

\$3500 The Elmer & Claudine Hane Memorial Scholarship – One \$3500

A tuition grant awarded to a deserving high school graduate of the East Iron Range area, based on need and promise with minimum GPA of 3.0 and enrolled at MRCTC as a full time student, pursuing the field of Medical Technology. Payment of this scholarship will be \$1500 for the fall semester and \$1500 for the spring semester, with criteria verification.

\$2250 The LaMarche Creek Foundation Scholarships – Two \$2250-Dual Campus*

A tuition grant awarded to two deserving high school graduates of the Iron Range area, based on need and promise with minimum GPA of 2.5 and enrolled at MRCTC as a full time student, pursuing the field of their choice. Payment of this scholarship will be \$1125 for the fall semester and \$1124 for the spring semester.

\$1500 The Raymond Prebilic Honor Scholarship – Two \$1500, one male, one female

A tuition grant awarded to two deserving high school graduates of the Iron Range area, based on need and promise with minimum GPA of 2.5 and enrolled at MRCTC as a full time student, pursuing the field of their choice. Payment of this scholarship will be \$750 for the fall semester and \$750 for the spring semester upon verification of criteria being met.

\$500 The Dave Stillman Memorial Scholarship – One \$500-Dual Campus*

One scholarship is awarded each year in memory of Dave Stillman, whose motto was "Livin the Dream". This award is directed to a deserving high school graduate of the Arrowhead Region of Northeastern Minnesota. The recipient must have received a letter in athletics, academics, music, etc. demonstrating commitment to his or her dream. It is based on need and promise with minimum GPA of 2.0 and enrolled at MRCTC as a full time student, pursuing the field of their choice.

\$500 MRCTC Faculty and Staff – Two \$500 –Dual Campus*

Recipient will be chosen on the basis of scholastic achievement (GPA 3.0), demonstration of skill & aptitude, record of good citizenship, school/community involvement and whose educational opportunities will be enhanced as a result of receiving this scholarship

\$300 The Carl and Marci Kaufman Memorial Scholarship – One 300

A tuition grant awarded to a deserving high school graduate of the East Iron Range area, based on need and promise without necessary demonstration of outstanding past achievement.

\$1000 Walfred H. Bodas Education Scholarship – One \$1000

One scholarship is awarded each year in memory of Walfred H. Bodas. The scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior enrolling at MRCTC as a full-time student. The student must be planning to make teaching his/her career. A minimum GPA of 3.5 during the students' senior year in high school is required.

\$350 Virginia All-Class Reunion Scholarship – One \$350
